What is TEMPO?

The Marin Symphony has a long tradition of reaching out to our community through educational programs for youth. These programs have, until now, been informal arrangements. We are now making them a centerpiece of our mission.

Introducing **TEMPO** - the Marin Symphony's new Youth Education Programs umbrella. This set of programs is designed to reach kids of all ages in Marin schools and provide structured musical learning experiences through three separate initiatives.

- **Outreach Tours**
- **Visiting Artists Program**
- **Symphony Day**

Outreach Tours

This program will bring small ensembles (string, horn or wind) to classrooms or assemblies as arranged by school administrators. Students will gather to hear live chamber music performed by Marin Symphony Orchestra members who will share their insights about the instruments, music and story-telling, listening skills, the history around the music or composer and what makes classical music relevant today. Material will be flexible and age appropriate.

This program is designed to fulfill State Criteria for music units at the primary level.

Visiting Artists Program

In September 2015, our Guest Artist, cellist Zuill Bailey, visited fifteen public and private schools over a 7 day period reaching over 2,200 students of all ages. The response was so overwhelmingly positive, we are making this a permanent feature of our TEMPO Programs.

Each season's guest artists will now be available to visit local schools to perform and provide personal learning and insights to students. Material will be adjusted according to grade level.

Symphony Day

With the help of the Marin Center and the Marin County School District, we are orchestrating a county-wide "Symphony Day" field trip for elementary school children throughout Marin. Students will see a live performance of a children's classic performed by the full Marin Symphony at the Marin Center.

Teachers and parents will receive preliminary materials and curriculum to help facilitate learning and make the most out of the experience.

Schools will be required to purchase tickets at deeply discounted prices. Operations will be covered by sponsors and the Marin Center.

Corporate sponsorship at all levels is needed to reach our \$80,000 goal to produce one concert each Spring.

Let's make it happen...

Once funded, Marin County schools will be provided with program information and a list of potential dates to schedule an **Outreach Tour** or a presentation from our **Visiting Artists**. **Symphony Day** will require further development and scheduling with Marin County Schools and Marin Center but it is scheduled for Spring 2016.

These programs will undoubtedly enrich the lives of the students they reach but they aren't free. They require funding to support the artists and musicians and provide curriculum materials for teachers and students.

With the generous and ongoing support of individuals and the local business community, these Marin Symphony Youth Education programs can become a reality for thousands of students throughout Marin.

Funding TEMPO

Your financial support of our TEMPO programs will provide funding to support all three Youth Education initiatives.
